

SUBJECT	CONTENT	CAN YOU HELP?
ENGLISH	Science Fiction Stories Persuasion texts Poetry Fables/Folktales Non-chronological reports Spelling/phonics	Hearing your child read at least three times a week and record this in their reading record. Talk to your child about their reading. Helping in school to hear children would be very useful. Supporting written and spelling homework.
MATHS	Continue work on addition, subtraction and multiplication/division. Moving to standard written calculations. Money; Using all coins and notes. Measurement. Know 3,4 and 8 times tables with division facts to match. Fractions and tenths. Shape (2D and 3D), perimeter and angles.	Help with homework set. Play games and practise times tables. Practise telling the time with your child. Make sure homework is brought in on time. Discuss termly targets.
SCIENCE	Plants Forces	Look at the local environment for plants. Try planting some bulbs or seeds with your children. Discuss and experiment with different forces (gravity and friction)
TOPICS	London (first half term) Ancient Greece (second half term)	Research on the internet Find books in the library Visit the British Museum and London landmarks
ART	Continuing to look at Kandinsky. Other art work on Ancient Greece. Focus on drawings in different mediums.	Discuss design for purpose at home
DESIGN TECHNOLOGY	Making smoothies.	Discuss different types of ingredients with your child.
COMPUTING	Collecting and analysing data. Internet safety.	Practise with your child at home if you have access to a PC. Discuss rules for staying safe when using the internet.
MUSIC	Three Little Birds – beginning to look at musical notation and creating different sounds.	Listen to and discuss different types of music.
P.E.	Rounders Athletics. Swimming.	Make sure your child has a white T shirt and black shorts for PE as well as a pair of suitable trainers. Swimming kit must be in school on a Thursday.
P.S.H.E	Relationships. Changes	Discuss changes in relationships. Talk with your child about moving on to their next class and teacher.
R.E.	Rules/special places of Christian and Islamic faith.	Discuss rules you have at home and the reasons for them.
