

SUBJECT	CONTENT	CAN YOU HELP?
ENGLISH	Myths and Legends, poetry, persuasive texts, including newspaper reports, letters and posters.	Read with your child – encourage your child to reflect how they feel about the book. To consider alternative view points – read newspapers and promotional material.
MATHS	Number work including decimals , fractions and percentages. Mixed word problems and real life maths. Time and timetables.	When doing homework encourage your child to show workings. Prompt child to use estimation to check answers look reasonable. Practise times tables/mental maths/telling the time/money (fast recall of answers).
SCIENCE	Plant life cycles. Human life cycles Keeping healthy.	Discuss topics with your child. Research at the Library/internet where relevant.
HISTORY/ GEOGRAPHY	Ancient Civilisations. Mountains. Map skills.	Research information i.e. using Library or internet. Discuss topics with your child.
ART/CRAFT	Islamic Art Props and scenery for year 5 and 6 production	
R.E.	Leaders in Judaism - Christianity. Creation Stories and Ultimate Questions they raise.	Encourage your child to be fair and see others point of view.
