<b>ENGLISH</b>	Writing linked to topics Researching and presenting information. Preparing and staging a play.	Encourage reading of different types of papers, cartoons. Writing e.g. information leaflets and stories. Talk to your child about their reading. Help to learn scripts.
<b>MATHS</b>	4 rules, fractions, percentages, word problems, ratio, algebra, units of measure. Revision for SATs. Pattern in number. Pattern in shape. Outdoors Maths. Problem solving	Times tables, solving problems related to every day situations e.g. change when shopping, estimating weights, measuring in the kitchen.
<b>SCIENCE</b>	Body Health Light Electricity	Encourage children to be aware of healthy lifestyle choices e.g. diet, exercise, personal hygiene
<b>GEOGRAPHY</b>	Maps- using keys and symbols Coasts Skills linked to topics	Research with children where appropriate
<b>HISTORY</b>	The Vikings	Visit your local library.
<b>ART</b>	Ongoing skills. Art linked to topics- Preparing props, costume and scenery for performance.	Help with costumes and props as appropriate.
<b>R.E.</b>	Buddhism. Christianity.	Encourage your child to be fair and see others' point of view.
<b>DESIGN TECHNOLOGY</b>	Designing and making an electrical game Costume and prop design. Textiles	Investigate how things work at home
<b>INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY</b>	Developing programming skills Using core programs such as Excel	Talk to your children about the website they go on and the appropriateness of them. Think about privacy settings they have on their social network profiles.
<b>MUSIC</b>	Preparation for Y5/Y6 show. Specialist sessions on composing Drumming lessons	Help children to learn the song words
<b>P.E.</b>	Athletics, Cricket and Rounders.	PE kit please – white T-shirt, black shorts, trainers.
<b>P.S.H.E.</b>	Relationships – self-awareness, managing feelings, choices Drug/Sex education. Changes and moving on.
